Training

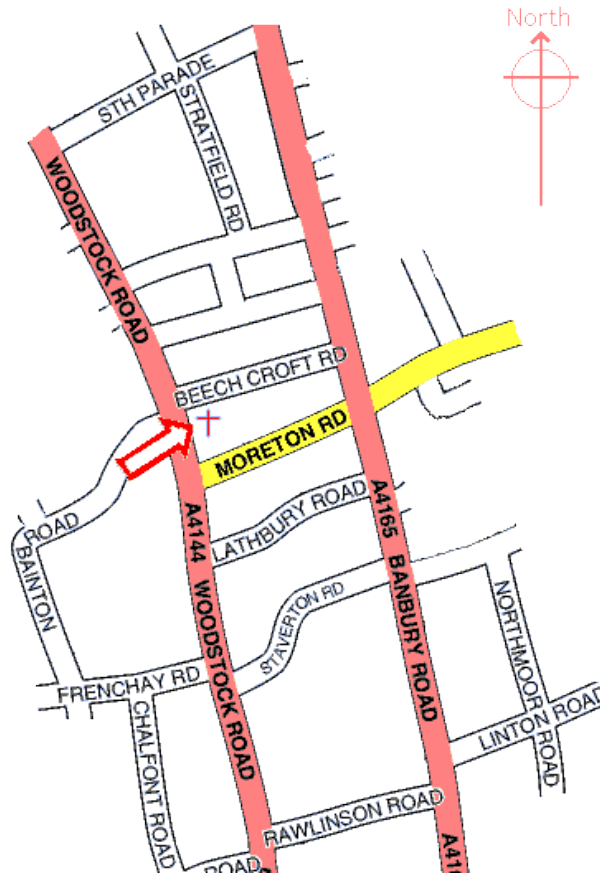

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Welcome To WRBC

We are a group of Christians who are committed to following Jesus Christ. This is our vision:

For God's glory in an attitude of worship and in dependence on God's Spirit we seek to:

We believe that God has given us five priority areas in which to express this:

We run a group called "Getting into the Church" for those new to the church: an opportunity to ask questions and learn how to get involved in the church.

We are partners in the Shout project that seeks to help the community on the Waterways estate opposite the church.

Sunday Services

We meet every Sunday at 10:30am and 6:30pm at the church.

During the morning service there is a crèche and Sunday School for the children. The morning service is followed by tea and coffee and during university term time a free lunch is provided.

The evening service is slightly more informal and often includes time for small group discussion and prayer.

Finding Out About Christianity

From time to time we run a Christianity Explored course for those who are interested in finding out more about Christianity in an informal and relaxed setting. There are opportunities to ask the questions you have.

Midweek Meetings

Homegroups meet at various venues on a Wednesday or Thursday almost every other week for Bible study, prayer and fellowship.

On the other weeks we meet together to pray in the church hall or hear a report from one of our missionaries.

Other meetings include women's and men's prayer breakfasts once each month and regular prayer meetings to pray for the church's missionary activities.

Young People/Students

Live Wires is for 4 to 11 year olds. Meeting on Tuesdays at 4:30pm for one hour for games, bible story and craft.

On Top is for 11 to 14 year olds. They meet on Tuesday evenings from 7:30pm to 9pm at the church for games and Bible study.

Our group for teenagers (14 to 18 year olds), meets weekly from 7:30pm to 9:45pm at 25 Maltfield Road for a talk from the Bible, time of discussion and fellowship.
