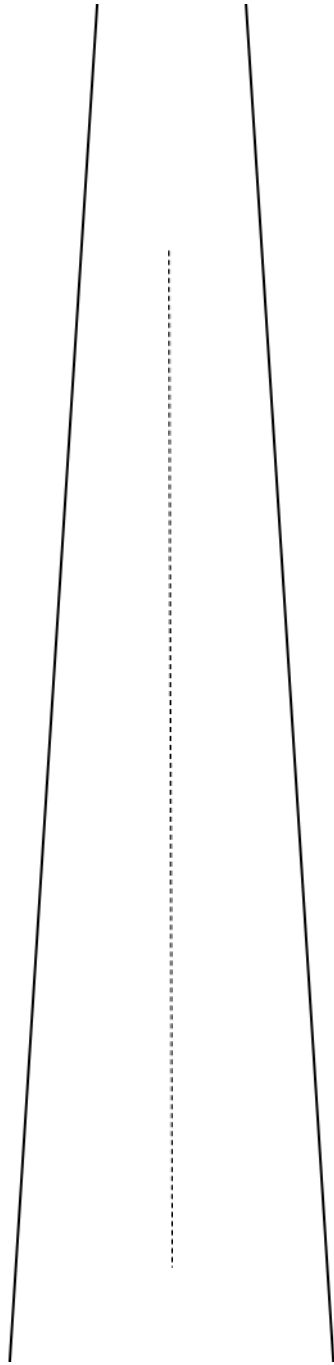

Cut out the flame and stick a toothpick on the back. Cut a slit through the middle of the path. Poke the toothpick through the slit to make the fire pass through the animals

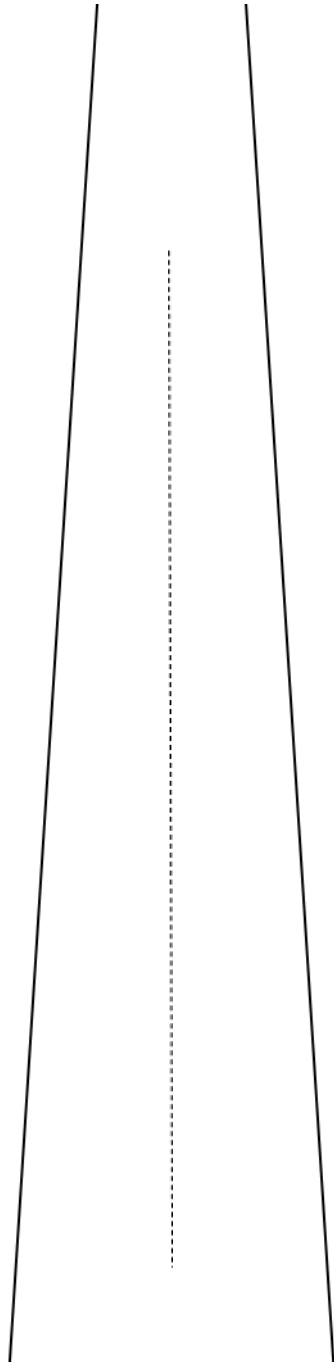
